Small Design Finishing

March 27, Saturday, 11a to 1p

Join Carol for a fun class where you don't have to stitch but you get to finish! You will learn two new techniques, assembly of an easel-type stand up and a 3-sided triangular shape. You will need to bring a stitched piece of needlework to class, pressed and ready to assemble, coordinating fabric for the backing, floss, perle cotton or ribbon for embellishments. Class fee \$10

Beginning Needle Felting

April 3, Saturday, 11a to 1p

Debbie will lead you step-by-step in this FUN and quick class. You will learn how to needle felt a small, wearable pin using a single felting needle, a stencil, wool roving and some wool backing. Sew a pin backing to the wool and you will have a wonderful, handmade pin that will surely receive loads of compliments from your friends. Class fee \$10 plus supplies.

Biscornu Finishing

April 24, Saturday, 11a to 1p

Are you intimidated by those lovely, little tuffets? Would you like to stitch one but are unsure how to do the assembly? The finishing is quite simple...really! Carol will work with you to put together your stitched biscornu in an easy-to-replicate finishing technique. You should bring to class your stitched pieces (top and bottom of biscornu), coordinating floss, 2 center buttons, a long, thin darning needle and straight pins. Optional pretties for your biscornu are seed beads for a beaded edge. Class fee is \$10

Cording & Tassels

May 8, Saturday, 11a to 1p

Learn how to give the perfect finishing touch to your needlework by making your own twisted cording and tassels. No need to buy prefinished when all it takes is some fiber and a few minutes of your time! Bring floss and perle cotton and an idea of a project you'd like to finish. Class fee is \$10
